RDA Alice Springs reaches some of the most vulnerable people in our community, helping them to achieve a sense of self-worth, resilience & personal achievement through the beauty of working with horses- equine assisted personal development is one of the most beautiful therapies available.

Why do you volunteer? I am passionate about seeing people's lives transformed & changed for the better. To be able to do that as part of my job...it doesn't get any better than that!

What achievements are you most proud of? In 2017 I won the Mayors Champion Award for the Disability sector-this award is given for "A person with or without disability who has been an advocate for the rights and well-being of people with disability". But what I think I am most proud of are our participants- how they overcome their fears, how they grow in confidence, how the selective mute starts to talk, how the painfully shy now instigate conversations, how those with anxiety learn to regulate their emotions, all because of the horses!
